NMEDA QAP REQUIREMENTS

Dealers who participate in the QAP are audited to extremely high standards.

They are required to:

- Undergo an inspection/audit process at least once annually by an independent auditing firm to ensure compliance to the NMEDA Guidelines, certain aspects of the Americans with Disabilities Act, the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration's (NHTSA) Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards (FMVSS) and "Make Inoperative" mandates.
- Have technicians trained and certified for the equipment they sell, install and service.
- Provide 24 hour emergency service to their customers.
- Have "certified" welders if they perform structural modifications to vehicles.
- Meet shop facility and equipment requirements, including four-corner scales to help ensure proper installation and service.
- Maintain records of all adaptive work.
- Maintain Product and Completed Operations and Garage Keepers insurance for liability purposes.
- Abide by the Mediation Committee's decisions when a complaint is lodged by a consumer.
